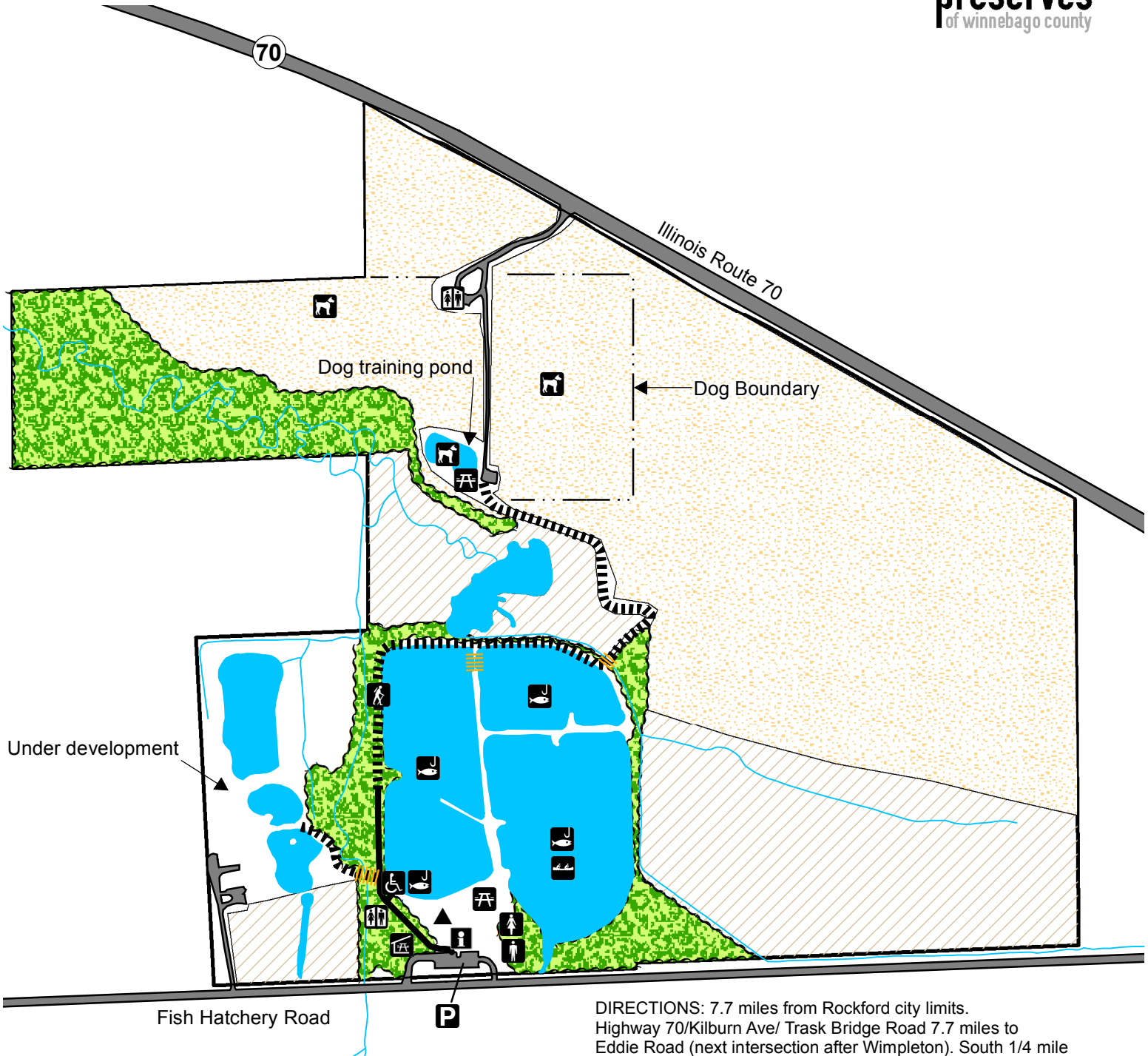


# FOUR LAKES FOREST PRESERVE

**DIRECTIONS:** 7.7 miles from Rockford city limits. Highway 70/Kilburn Ave/ Trask Bridge Road 7.7 miles to Eddie Road (next intersection after Wimpleton). South 1/4 mile to Fish Hatchery Road. West 1 mile to preserve entrance.

**FACILITIES:** 30 acre preserve (about 18 acres of fishing lakes). Fish stocked in 1981 include bluegills, channel catfish, largemouth bass, walleye, brown bullheads, redear sunfish, northern pike, golden and silver shiners, fathead minnows. Large grill, water, and toilets on site. Dikes around lakes.

**LAKE VIEW:** Wood shelter. 8 tables - seats 54 people. No electricity. Limit 80 people.

Docks are handicap accessible  
 Preserve open at 7:00a.m.- closed 1/2 hour after sunset. **ALL RESERVATIONS SUBJECT TO GENERAL USE REGULATION.**
